

- Army reserve infantry - 23 grenadier bns
- Cav Div Kilmaine - Unchanged; *i.e.* 5 & 20 DR, 1 & 7 HR, 10 & 24 ChR.

### **Battle of Castiglione, 5 August 1796**

Bonaparte was in command; he had 35,000 men of whom 1100 became casualties. Artillery consisted of 32 guns, divided among the divisions. Please note that the actual assignment of units to the Divs is not identical to the revised 2 Aug O/B (above), and that the cavalry in particular were attached to various commands rather than under united.

NOTE: There were other actions at Castiglione, including one a few days previously; the unit histories don't always accurately distinguish between the "Battle" and the actions.

- Div Massena - 11, 18, 32 DB; 4 Lt DB; 15 DR, 25 ChR
- Div Augereau - 4, 45, 51 DB; I & II Bns/69 DB; 17 Lt DB; 20 DR, 22 ChR, 1 HR
- Beaumont's Command (from Kilmaine's Reserve Div) - 5, 6 & 7 Combined Grenadier Bns; 5 DR, 10 ChR, 7 *bis* HR
- Part of Div Despinoy (which he brought up as reinforcements) - Just 5 DB
- Div Sérurier (led by Fiorella; came up from Mantua to strike the enemy from behind) - 19 DB; III Bn/69 DB; 12 Lt DB; 8 DR

### **Battle of Neresheim, 11 August 1796**

Involved 50,000 men from the Rhin et Moselle Army; casualties were 1200 dead and wounded, 1200 captured.

### **Battle of Amberg, 24 August 1796**

Involved 34,000 men from the Sambre-et Meuse Army. 1200 were killed and wounded, 800 captured. Order of battle identical to that of Würzburg (see 3 September).

### **Battle of Würzburg, 3 September 1796**

Jourdan was commanding the Sambre et Meuse Army. He had 25,000 foot and 5000 horse. Losses were 2000 killed and wounded, 1000 captured and 7 guns (Unless noted, each DB had 3 bns)

- Div Lefebvre - 43, 83, 96, 105 DB; 25 Light DB; 8 CR (4), 11 DR (4), 1 ChR (3), 9 ChR (3), 4 HR (3); one sqdn of 16 DR; two foot and two horse batteries
- Div Grenier - 16, 67 DB ; Ist Bn of 23 DB; 20 Light DB; 1 DR, 2 DR, 6 ChR (size of the cav regts unknown); one foot, one horse batteries
- Div Championnet - 61, 78, 92 DB; 8 Light DB; 12 DR (4), 12 ChR (4); two foot, one horse batteries
- Div Bernadotte - 9, 37, 49, 88 DB; 7 DR (4), 14 DR (4), 3 ChR (4), 2 HR (3); one foot, two horse batteries
- Reserve cavalry (Bonneau) - 4, 7, 10, 17 CR (each of 4 sqdns); two horse batteries.
