

-XXVI Corps

Mobilized in June 1940 as the "Albania Command", but from fall 1940 was more often called XXVI Corps

- Commanders: In 6/40 = Sebastiano Visconti-Prasca; in 10/40 & 4/41 = Gabriele Nasci; in 9/43 = ???
- Fought in Albania for 10/40-4/41 campaigns; in 4/41 Nasci led a combination of III and XXVI Corps units against south Yugoslavia; Corps was in the Greek garrison, 5/41-9/43; in 9/43 the HQ was at Janina (NW Greece)

-XXX Corps [1941-43]

Formed in 1941; destroyed in May 1943

- Commanders: In 11/42 = _ Sogno
- In Italy until 11/42, then went to the new front in Tunisia; defensive actions in Tunisia until the surrender in 5/43

-XXX Corps [1943]

Reformed in July 1943 in the Sardinia garrison

- Commanders: ???
- Still on Sardinia in 9/43

-XXXI Corps

Formed in 1941

- Commanders: In 11/41 & 9/43 = Mario Priore
- Served on coast defense and in garrison in south Italy; in 9/43 the HQ was at Catanzaro, under 7 Army

-XXXV Corps [1941-43]

Formed in June 1941 as "Italian Expeditionary Corps in Russia" (Italian acronym = C.S.I.R.); in June 1942 became XXXV Corps; dissolved in Feb 1943

- Commanders: Giovanni Messe, 6/41 to spring 1942; then ???
- On the Russian front from 6/41; it was the highest level Italian HQ on this front until the 8 Army arrived (with two more Corps HQ) in summer 1942; routed on the Don in winter 1942-43; left the line in 1/43 and dissolved in 2/43

-XXXV Corps [1943]

Formed in June 1943

- Commanders: ???
