- Northern Battle Group of 3rd Baltic Front - History obscure; appears in OB of the Front on 1 Sept 1944 but not in any subsequent OB. Had CXVI Corps (86, 146 RD); CXVIII Corps (128, 282, 326 RD); 291 RD; 14 Fort Sector; 2 Artillery Div; 16 Tank Bde; 37 Gd Cps AR; 361 Gd, 724 SP AR; 705 AT Regt; 8 Flamethrower Bn; 52 Gd Heavy Cannon Bn; 72 AA Bn
- Novgorod Group - Formed in July 1941 for Northwest Front (II Ban troops); on 7 August the original group HQ became 48th Army (which was dissolved in Sept 1941), but the group was immediately reformed and served under NW Front through Dec 1941. Fought on the southern approaches to Leningrad [*], 10 July-30 Sept 1941; Battle of Tikhvin [*], 10 Nov-30 Dec 1941
